Just a reminder to please bring your child to school dressed and ready for water play with bathing suit, towel and swim shoes, and have them here by 9:30 am for water play on their appropriate day. The schedule is as follows:

- Wednesdays - Preschool I
- Thursdays - Preschool II
- Fridays - Pre-kindergarten

Don't forget to send in a change of clothes for them after water play, including shoes.

Remember to please put sunscreen on at home before you drop your child off, and if you would like us to re-apply sunscreen, you must sign the sunscreen form and remember to have the child's name on EVERYTHING!

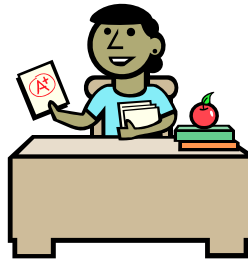
Children should wear tennis shoes to school. Sandals, crocs and other open shoes are not permitted, as these shoes are unsafe for outdoor play. Also, it is dangerous for children to play on climbing equipment in sandals or other open shoes. For the children's safety, please make sure to send your child to school in appropriate shoes. Also, make sure that your child's spare clothes box has summer clothes in it, along with an extra pair of shoes.



Please make sure that you sign your child into and out of the center each day.

Please check with Jill or Amy in the office to see if you qualify for your "free" vacation week. If not, please make sure that you **pay in advance** before you leave on vacation. You may post-date the check if you wish.

Pre-kindergarten parents only: Please make sure to turn in your SACC paperwork if you plan to have your child in our SACC program in the fall. You can pick up registration forms in the office. If we don't receive SACC paperwork from you, we will assume that your child's last day here will be Wednesday, August 29th.
