FALL ENROLLMENT IN SCHOOL AGED CHILD CARE (SACC):

We currently accept students from Stratford Landing Elementary School, Hollin Meadows Elementary School, Fort Hunt Elementary School and Waynewood Elementary School. Also, please keep in mind that enrolling in our SACC program guarantees you a spot in our summer camp!

Summer Camp!

Summer Camp officially begins on Monday, June 18th !! **Everyone must have a water shirt from last year or purchase one** at the cost of \$25 per shirt. The use of these water shirts is MANDATORY on water park days, as they allow our counselors to easily identify our campers in the pools. Camp shirts and water shirts are not available as of yet, but we will send an email when they are ready for pick-up. You may speak to Ms. Jill or Ms. Amy if you have any other questions about the summer camp program. Please keep in mind that the summer camp schedule is always subject to change due to weather or other circumstances.

Each camper receives 5 camp t-shirts included as part of the registration fee. The children must wear one of these orange camp t-shirts every day that they attend camp. Also, please remember that campers must bring a brown paper bag lunch every day labelled with their full name and the date unless otherwise stated. Additionally, no electronics or cell phones are permitted in camp unless it is designated as a special "electronics-allowed" day.
